
In continuation of this office notification no. F1(1)(4)DM&R/Gen./2009/11723-70 dated 25/08/09, regarding scarcity declaration, for providing labour employment in the scarcity affected villages of following districts; under Calamity Relief Fund, on the basis of information provided by the respective District Collectors, the labour ceiling for the month of March, 2010 is being indicated as under:-

Following instruction in this regard may please be followed strictly:-

1. The instructions given by Disaster Management & Relief Department in आपदा प्रबन्धन एवं सहायता निर्देशिका issued vide letter No.F.1 (2) (1) DM&R / R.W./05 dated 1-9-05 and dated 17.9.09 should be strictly followed in selection of works and engagement of labour and payment of wages etc.
2. The labour ceiling given to the districts should not be exceeded.
3. Labour ceiling should be utilized for completing incomplete works of previous relief year on priority and thereafter remaining labour ceiling can be utilized for new relief works as per आपदा प्रबन्धन एवं सहायता निर्देशिका.
4. Only labour component shall be borne on relief works from Relief head and the material component be arranged either from the on going programmes/ schemes of various department or from budget of the concerning department. No expenditure under material component shall be permissible under CRF.
5. The labour ceiling given for the relief works should primarily be utilized for creation of public assets.
6. Labour shall only be engaged from eligible families who have completed 100 days under NREGA in the current financial year. This wage employment shall be provided for 10 days in a month on a rotational basis to any one member of such eligible families.
7. The mode of payment shall be as per NREGA system.
8. The amount of wages shall be calculated on task basis as per the task rate under NREGA so that there are uniform task rates between NREGA and Relief Works.
